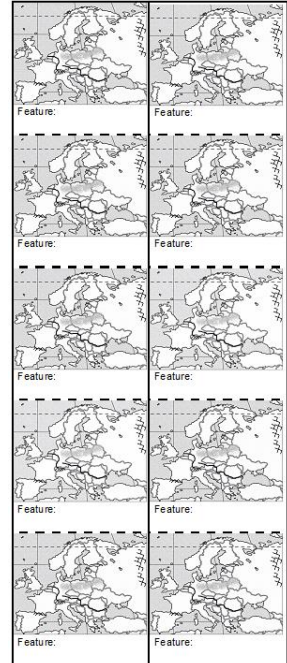
## Europe Physical Features Foldable Directions

Fold the two image columns forward to create a foldable where the two image columns are side to side.

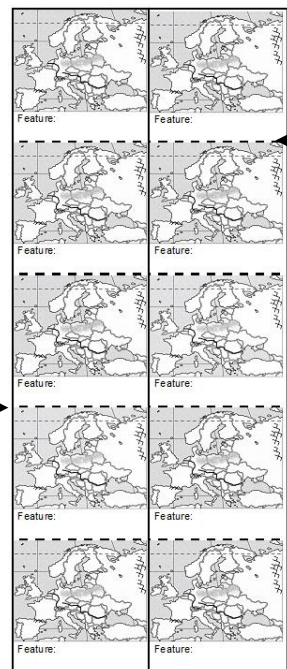
