Over 2 million visitors visit the Great Barrier Reef each year.

Astronauts can see it from space.





Around 10 percent of the world's total fish species can be found just within the Great Barrier Reef.

The Great Barrier Reef is home to a wide range of life, including fish, giant clam, seahorse, sea snakes, nudibranch, sea turtles, stingray, sharks and many more.

The Great Dividing Range is located along the eastern coast of Australia

The Great Victoria Desert is located in Australia's southern interior.


Its name is from British

It is one of Australia's most popular tourist spots next to the Coral Sea and Great Barrier Reef.




Ayers rock is six-mile-wide and nearly twelve-story's tall.

Iron present in Ayers Rock causes it to rust at the surface and turn a reddish color. Uluru plays a prominent role in local Aboriginal creation myths.
