Based on your knowledge and research about Canada and its environmental issues follow the steps below to choose and create your project.

Step 1: Choose an environmental issue in Canada. Propose a solution that involves the government and the citizens. How do we fix the problem? Pick One.

- > Acid Rain in the Great Lakes
- > Deforestation
- > Extraction of Fossil Fuels

Step 2: Brainstorm multiple solutions and pick ONE solution.

Step 3: Decide how you want to present your project. **Choose One.**

1. Write an essay on the topic (at least 3 paragraphs)
2. Infographic Poster (images AND writing)
3. Comic Strip
4. Storyboard at <https://www.storyboardthat.com/>
5. Song/Rap/Poem (Can be submitted to flipgrid as well)
6. Skit/Commercial/PSA Script
7. Powerpoint

Step 4: **Research** and Draft out your problem and solution. You can use your notes and any outside resource.

Step 5: **Create your project!**

Your final response must include:

- At least one environmental issue that needs to be solved
- At least one possible solution
- At least one way the government can be involved
- At least one way people can contribute directly
