Latitude and Longitude



A grid consists of imaginary lines to help determine location on the earth.




Latitude

Lines of latitude are imaginary lines that run from east to west. They are also called parallels.



Longitude

Lines of <u>longitude</u> are imaginary lines that run from north to south. They are also called meridians.



Equator and Prime Meridian

SAMPLE

Equator

The equator is an imaginary line at zero degrees that runs from east to west. It is a line of latitude.

Prime Meridian

The Prime Meridian is an imaginary line at zero degrees that runs from north to south. It is a line of longitude.
