It extends from Mexico to the southernmost tip of the South American Continent.


Central America is a part of Latin America. Central America is located below Mexico but above Columbia.

The Panama Canal is located in Panama and is known as the central American land bridge.


It connects the Pacific ocean with the Atlantic Ocean.

It was completed in 1914 and took over 10 years to build.


Thousands of people their lives due to construction accidents.

It is the world's highest mountain range outside of Asia.






The Atacama Desert is located on South America's western coast.


It is located primarily in Chile.
