- ▶ Social Groups (Ethnic Groups (Hispanic, af. American, religious groups or who you hang out with)

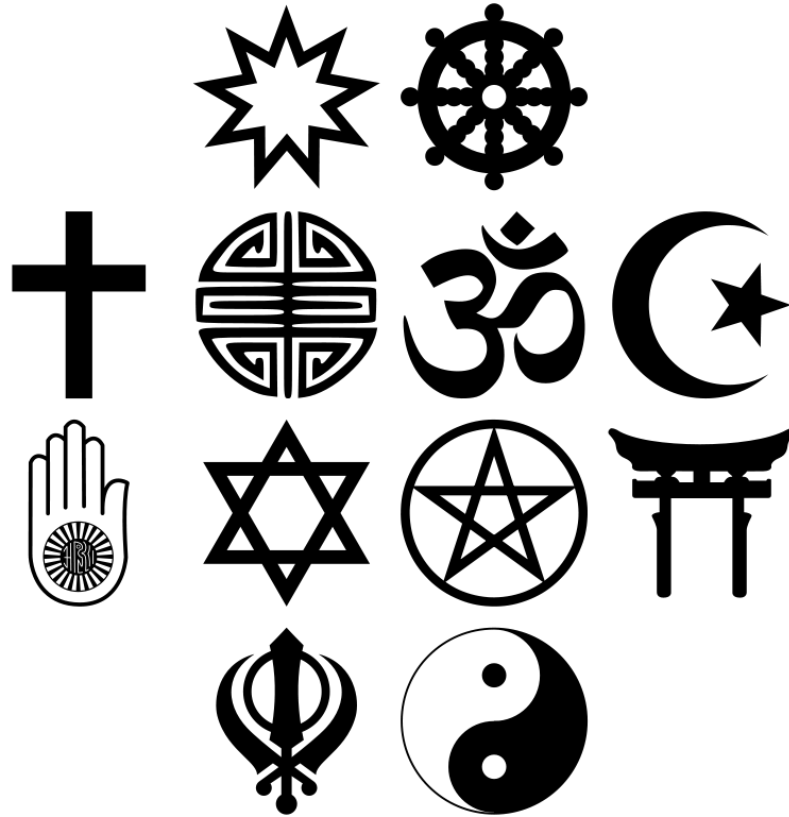
# LANGUAGE
