

World War One

Germany

- Architect of the Alliance System
- Allies with Austria-Hungary and Italy
- Isolated France
- Worried about Russia
- Competitive with Britain about navy



Austria-Hungary

- Long-standing alliance with Germany
- Not friendly with Italy (even with alliance)
- Took Bosnia in 1908
- Wants more land in the Balkans
- Enemy of Serbia and Russia



Italy

- Weakest of the Great Powers
- Joined Triple
 Alliance with
 Germany and
 Austria-Hungary,
 but unfriendly with
 Austria-Hungary
 Austria-Hungary
- Worried Austria-Hungary might get too strong



Russia

- Growing power
- Allies with France
- Allies with Serbia
- Enemies with Austria because of Balkans
- Enormous resources
- Weak government



France

- Wants revenge on Germany
- Allies with Russia to surround Germany
- Repairs relationship with Britain
- Very strong army, used to be #1
- Wants to fight Germany and reclaim losses



Great Britain

- Richest, most powerful empire
- Ruler of the oceans
- Concerned with German navy
- Settles disputes with France and Russia
- Naval alliance with Japan
- No alliances, but common interests






Serbia

- Wants to create large Slav nation (Yugoslavia)
- Desire for Balkan independence
- History of rebellions against the Ottomans
- Shared ethnicity with Russia
- Enemies with Austria





Assassination

- Archduke Franz Ferdinand is killed in Sarajevo
- Serbian terrorist is the murderer
- Serbia claims innocence
- Austria blames Serbia anyway



The Blank Check

- Before deciding about Serbia, Austria ask Germany
- Germany encourages Austria to crush Serbia
- Offers Austria anything they need (Blank Check)
- Austria sends ultimatum to Serbia demanding Austrian troops enter their country



Pan-Slavism

- Serbia asks Russia for help
- Russia promises assistance
- Fighting Austria means fighting Germany
- Russia urges Serbia to negotiate
- Austria declares war anyway
- Russia declares war on Austria and Germany



The Plan

- Germany had a plan for fighting on two fronts
- The Von Schleiffen Plan
- Ignore Russia and quickly attack France
- Speed is key beat
 France before Russia is
 ready
- The German-French border is heavily guarded




The Back Door

- Belgium lays between France and Germany
- Signed Neutrality Treaty in 1839
- Germany wants to cut through and avoid French forces
- Belgian king refuses, sends his small army to fight
- This delays Germany, but more importantly...



Britain's Dilemna

- Wants to keep control of trade and markets
- Doesn't want to fight, but worried about Germany
- Once the war starts, Britain has to choose
- Invasion of Belgium gives them a reason to fight
- Saves Paris but fails to beat Germany



Loose Ends

- Italy backed out of the Triple Alliance
- Joined The Allied Powers a year later
- The Ottoman Empire joined Germany and Austria to try and win back Balkan land
- Japan quickly established control of Asia seas
